GAMES

There are a multitude of different games that are designed for weddings, we have added 2 of our favorites to this questionnaire but if you have any other game ideas that you would like, please let us know!

Shoe Game

The wedding shoe game is an increasingly popular reception activity. While many still haven't heard of it, it just might be played at the next wedding you attend, so here's a rundown on how it works.

1. The bride and groom are seated on chairs in the middle of the venue, back-to-back.
2. Both the bride and groom remove their shoes and exchange one so that they are both holding one of each shoe. The bride will have one of her shoes and one of her partner's shoes. The groom will have one of his shoes and one of his partner's shoes.
3. During the game, a series of questions are asked, and the answer is either "the bride" or "the groom." The bride and groom answer by holding up the shoe of the correct answer. For instance, if the question was "Who usually cooks breakfast" and the answer is the groom, they should both hold up the groom's shoes.
4. The game usually lasts about 10 minutes with a series of 20–30 questions being asked.

WEDDING SCAVENGER HUNT

The Scavenger Hunt is another increasingly popular reception games! It is far less known than the shoe game but just as fun if not more! It is similar to musical chairs, This is how it works.

1. There are 8 chairs placed back to back in the middle of the venue.
2. The Bride and Groom each pick 4 people from the crowd to participate in the game.
3. All 8 people sit in the chairs
4. The DJ will call out certain items to locate. (IE a food receipt, a cowboy boot, ETC)
5. The players must get the items from someone in the crowd! They CANNOT use an item that they personally have.
6. While the players are gathering the item, the DJ will remove one chair so that someone will not have a chair.
7. This continues until there is only 1 chair and one winner!
